

## **Membership of the Urban Design Committee**

The Urban Design Committee shall be comprised of up to eighteen (18) voting Members and three (3) non-voting Members appointed by the Board or the Executive Committee, as follows:

1. Eight (8) Members who are residents of, own property in or work in Rosslyn.
2. Three (3) Members of the RBIC Board, at least one (1) of whom shall be a member of the Executive Committee.
3. One (1) Member from each of the North Rosslyn Civic Association and the Radnor-Fort Myer Heights Civic Association.
4. Up to five (5) additional at-large Members, who are Arlington County citizens and/or professionals that express an interest in, or are involved with, urban design issues in Rosslyn. Persons, who hold seats on the Urban Design Committee as additional at-large Members, should consist of Persons from among the following constituencies:
  - a. Urban Design Professionals should exhibit the following expertise:
    - urban design
    - architecture
    - landscape architecture
    - urban/city planning
    - property management
  - b. Owners of real property in Rosslyn.
  - c. Owners of businesses in Rosslyn.
  - d. Residents of Rosslyn, or
  - e. Residents of Arlington County who have expressed special interest in the BID Assessment Area and/or Rosslyn.
5. Three (3) non-voting Members appointed by the Board, one each from at least three (3) of the following governmental bodies:
  - a. Arlington Department of Community Planning, Housing & Development (CPHD);
  - b. Arlington Department of Environmental Services (DES);
  - c. Arlington Co. Department of Parks, Recreation & Cultural Resources (PRCR);
  - d. Arlington Co. Department of Economic Development (AED);
  - e. National Parks Service (NPS);
  - f. Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT); or
  - g. National Capital Planning Commission (NCPC);
  - h. RBIC Staff.
